

The Distribution of Amphibians in the Volga-Kama Region

РЕЗЮМЕ. Распространение земноводных в Волжско-Камском крае. В.И. Гаранин. Обзор данных о распространении земноводных в Волжско-Камском крае. Даны карты точек находок и кадастры распространения сибирского углозуба (*Salamandrella keyserlingii*), обыкновенного (*Triturus vulgaris*) и гребенчатого (*T. cristatus*) тритонов, краснобрюхой жерлянки (*Bombina bombina*), обыкновенной чесночницы (*Pelobates fuscus*), обыкновенной (*Bufo bufo*) и зеленой (*B. viridis*) жаб, озерной (*Rana ridibunda*), прудовой (*R. lessonae*), съедобной (*R. kl. esculenta*), остромордой (*R. arvalis*) и травяной (*R. temporaria*) лягушек. Данные охватывают 719 точек находок по 230 административным районам, 15 областям и республикам. Приводятся годы наблюдений и источники информации.

ABSTRACT. Overview of the data on the distribution of *Salamandrella keyserlingii*, *Triturus vulgaris*, *T. cristatus*, *Bombina bombina*, *Pelobates fuscus*, *Bufo bufo*, *B. viridis*, *Rana ridibunda*, *R. lessonae*, *R. kl. esculenta*, *R. arvalis* and *R. temporaria* to the east of the Russian Plain, in the Volga and Kama river basins, between 52° and 59°N and 44-56° E. Information on each species includes lists of localities (totally 719 localities for 230 administrative districts, 15 provinces and republics) with data on years of observation and sources of data as well as maps.

STUDY AREA

The Volga-Kama region is the territory at the east of the Russian Plain, formed by the basin of the Volga River and its tributary Kama, between 52 and 59°N and 44-56°E, i.e. between the meridians of Saransk and Ufa cities and parallels of Kirov and Orenburg cities (Popov, 1960). This area has been studied by zoologists from Kazan City for many years. The region covers about 525 thousand square km (this paper, however, embraces more than 700 thousand sq. km). This area is much larger than any European country, even those such as the Ukraine.

The region includes the lowlands of the valleys of the Volga, Kama, Vyatka, Belaya, Sura, Sviyaga and other rivers, as well as elevated hilly areas, such as the northern part of the Obshchii Syrt, Bugulminsko-Belebeevskaya, spurs of Ural Mountains north to the Kama River: Sarapulskaya and Mozhginskaya elevations, many spurs on the right bank of the Kama and the left bank of the Volga: Tikhie Gory, Svinye Gory, Sokolii Gory, Sorochii Gory, Vyatskii Uval, as well as Privolzhskaya elevation on the right bank of the Volga and its

subdivisions: Uslonskie Gory, Tetyushskie Gory, Shchuchii Gory, Undorskie Gory, Sengileevskie Gory, Zhiguli etc. In the south-east of the region, and including also the northern and western districts of Orenburg Province, part of the Ural river basin is included: namely the Sakmara River and its tributaries. In general, the Volga-Kama Region includes (either partly or totally) 15 administrative provinces and republics to the east of European Russia: the republics of Marii El, Chuvashia, Tatarstan, Udmurtia, Bashkortostan, as well as Ulyanovskaya and Samarskaya provinces, almost the whole of the Nizhegorodsk and Samara provinces, the south-east region of the Kostroma and the south-west of the Perm provinces, the eastern part of Mordovia Republic and the Penza Province, the extreme north of the Saratov Province, as well as the north and west of the Orenburg province. The amphibian distribution in these areas is described in this paper.

Vegetation types in the region includes taiga forests, namely, dark taiga in the north-east and the southern taiga (pine forests) in the north-west. There are also broad-leaved forests with oak and associated plants in the west, secondary small-leaved forests with birch and aspen, mixed forests and finally forest steppe and steppe towards the south. The expansion of the open landscapes from the south is alleviated by anthropogenic activity.

Air temperatures above freezing are important for amphibians. In this regard, it should be observed that mean daily temperatures exceed +10°C by 1 May in the south of the region (north of Saratov and Samara provinces but not the north of Orenburg Province). To the north of the region (Kostroma and Kirov provinces, north of Udmurtia and Perm Province) this takes place at least ten days later (Popov, 1960). The latter line is almost coincident with the southern margin of the range of *Salamandrella keyserlingii* and the northern margin of the range of *Triturus cristatus*. North of this line, stable snow cover remains for at least 150 days of the year. From the south of the other line mentioned above (exceeding of mean daily temperatures above +10°C since 1 May) the snow cover remains for less than 140 days.

Landscape types in the Volga-Kama Region are quite diverse and can be distinguished into 24 large major types. Four of them are related to dark forest types composed of spruce and fir with an admixture of pine and leafed trees; 5 relate to pine with an admixture of broad-leaved trees; 2 belong to broad-leaved forests; 2 to birch forests, 2 to aspen forests, as others comprise floodland forests and hills. Other habitat complexes are forest rides and band forests; steppe areas, including pastures; meadows, including floodland meadows; shores of water bodies and fields; and human settlements. Each group includes several subdivisions. Although this scheme was elaborated for birds in 1977, it is applicable also to amphibians.

HISTORY OF STUDY

The first mention of some of the amphibian and reptile species in the Volga-Kama Region belongs to the time of first Academic expeditions (1768 – 1774), when they were

described in this territory: *Rana ridibunda* Pallas, found in the Volga delta and upper reaches, and by J.G. Georgi in spring 1774 in the area of Kazan City (Georgi, 1775; Pallas, 1776, [1814]); *Bufo viridis* Laur., *Pelobates fuscus* Laur., etc. The third volume of the "Zoographia Rosso-Asiatica" by P.S. Pallas, published in 1814 (Svetovidov, 1976) contains data on 11 species of amphibians. Among them, the following species also live in the Volga-Kama Region: *Lacerta aquatica* (=*Triturus cristatus* (Laur.)), *Rana cruenta* (=*Bombina bombina* (L.)), *Rana bufo* (=*Bufo bufo* (L.)), *Rana arborea* (=*Hyla arborea* (L.)), *Rana esculenta* (=*R. esculenta* L., *R. lessonae* Cam.), *Rana temporaria* (=*R. temporaria* L., *R. arvalis* Nilss.). Thus, almost all amphibian species, known here at present, were also noted in the 18th century. Subsequent records do not extend this list significantly (except for *Salamandrella keyserlingii*), but added further minor details. For example, B.V. Krasavtsev found the latter species in July 1930 in the Nizhegorodskii Region (now Kostromskaya Province): this was the first record of this species in Europe (1931); D.L. Nikiforov (1966) in Marii El Republic, A.M. Bolotnikov with co-writers (1968) in Permskaya Province, V.A. Ushakov (1978) in Gorky (Nizhegorodskaya) Province, A.N. Solovjov (1991) in Kirovskaya Province later reported this species. It is more difficult to analyze the priority of other records, but it is possible to determine the first more or less full description of batrachofauna of different parts of the region. For example, for Nizhegorodskaya Province this is the list made by N.A. Varpakhovskii (1888), for Kazanskaya Province lists by N.A. Varpakhovskii (1884, 1885) and M.D. Ruzskii (1894), for Vyatskaya Province by L.K. Krulikovskii (1888 – 1914), and for the Orenburgskii Region by N.A. Zarudnoi (1896). Subsequent overviews have been published after the well-known monograph on the amphibians and reptiles of Russian Empire (Nikolsky, 1918), i.e. during the Soviet era. Among them, the works by P.A. Dryagin (1926) on the Vyatskaya Region, A.N. Formozov (1935) on the Gorky Region, P.V. Terentjev (1935) on Chuvashia, P.A. Polozhentsev (1937, 1941) on the contemporary Ulyanovskaya and Samarskaya provinces, P.A. Polozhentsev and M.G. Khanislamov (1942) on Bashkiria, as well as I.I. Puzanov with cowriters (1942) on Gorky (now Nizhegorodskaya) Province. The second editions of the last two titles were published in 1949 and 1955 respectively.

Since the end of the Second World war in 1945, numerous overviews on particular regions have appeared containing lists of amphibian species. In 1949, the third edition of the well-known guide of amphibians and reptiles of the USSR was published by P.V. Terentjev and S.A. Chernov. The first two editions were published in 1936 and 1940. The work by V.A. Popov and A.V. Lukin (1949) on the vertebrates of the Tatarian ASSR was one of the first regional overviews of this kind to be published after the war. This work contained a list of 10 amphibian species with brief accounts of their ecology. The 2nd and 3rd editions of this book contained chapters on amphibians with necessary additions prepared by V.I. Garanin (1971, 1988). In a book on the fauna of the Urals (Shvarts et al., 1951), amphibians of this region were described and original data on their ecology were presented. In the same year a note on the amphibians of the Kuibyshevskaya

(now Samara) province was published (Shikleev, 1951). A.P. Raiskii (1951, 1954) published data on the amphibians of Chkalovskaya (now Orenburgskaya) Province. Collective work by zoologists from Kazan City headed by V.A. Popov provided the results of studies of the fauna of the flood zone of the Kuibyshevskoe Reservoir. This work includes data on amphibian species in the valleys of the Kama and Volga rivers above the Zhiguli Mountains. This work was published in the Proceedings of Kazan State University in 1954. Amphibian species were noted also in the subsequent collections of papers, "Nature of Penza Province" (1955) and "Nature of Kirovskaya Province" (1960). Data on amphibians of Chuvashia were published by I.M. Olinger et al. (1966), on amphibians of Udmurtia by Yu.K. Popov (1972). Materials from the Volga-Kama Region were used in the well-known books "Animal Life" (A.G. Bannikov ed., 1969, 1985) and the guide to amphibians and reptiles of the USSR (Bannikov et al., 1977).

Later, some data on amphibians were mentioned in the faunistic works on Kirovskaya Province (Koroleva, 1976), Udmurtia (Priezzhev and Popov, 1963), Mari El (Efremov, 1984), Kuibyshevskaya Province (Gorelov, 1990), Chuvashia (Voronov, 1990), Orenburgskaya Province (Gavlyuk et al., 1993), Ulyanovskaya Province (Osipova, 1993) and Bashkiria (Bayanov, 1995). In 1984, the Red Data Book of Bashkiria was published. It listed the following amphibian species as rare in this republic: *Triturus cristatus*, *Bufo bufo*, *Rana lessonae* and *R. temporaria*. In 1995, the Red Data Book of Tatarstan was published. It is not only a manual, but also the official legal document. Only two species of amphibians were included in that Red Data Book, *T. cristatus* and *B. bufo*. Only one general review exists for this territory (Garanin, 1983). However, this work now needs a serious reappraisal. This includes, in particular, data on geographic distributions: the book contains neither names of localities of amphibian records, nor cadastres.

Finally, there are many studies of different aspects of amphibian ecology, in particular habitat distribution, population numbers, food (e.g., Motkova, 1977; Belova, 1965) etc.

SOME PECULIARITIES OF THE AMPHIBIAN DISTRIBUTION

The species composition of reptiles in the Volga-Kama Region becomes richer towards the south. *Vipera ursinii* appears southwards from the Kama River, *Emys orbicularis* from the Cheremshan River, *Eremias arguta*, *Natrix tessellata* and *Elaphe dione* from the Samarskaya Luka, etc. Amphibians, however, display a different pattern. *Salamandrella keyserlingii* exists in the northern part of the region and disappears in the south, although in the recent past it penetrated the southern parts of the region as far as the foothills of the Bashkirian Urals Mountains. The composition of other amphibian species does not change from the north to the south, though some species do become rare: *T. cristatus*, *B. bufo*, *R. temporaria*, *Rana lessonae* and, probably *R. kl. esculenta* disappear from the southern part of the region. *Rana lessonae* has penetrated Eastern Europe from the west via broad-leaved forests, and its range reaches the lower regions of the Vyatka River, except for its lowermost parts, as well as the

Kama and middle Volga rivers and areas of the Zhiguli and Samara Rivers. Northern species of amphibians become more and more seldom from the lower current of the Kama River southwards. The presence of *Rana temporaria* there is clearly associated with underground water sources, while *B. bufo* inhabits the relic areas of wet forests. The distribution of *T. cristatus* populations seems to relate also to clear forest ponds.

At the same time, it is necessary to note the past presence of *T. cristatus* in the delta of the Volga River (Zoological Museum of Kazan University no. DK 15, 4 specimens, Astrakhan City, 19th Century). Probably, they were collected by V. Khelbnikov, who provided *T. vulgaris* from the same location to the Zoological Museum of Russian Academy of Sciences (2 specimens, ZISP 1612 and 1882). A.M. Nikolsky (1918), K.P. Paraskiv and P.M. Butovskii (1960) doubted the validity of this last record. However, there is a specimen of *T. vulgaris* in the Zoological Museum of Kazan University (no. DK 21) labelled as "Temir-baba. Vost. bereg Kasp. morya. T. Peltsam", i.e. "Temir-Baba, eastern shore of Caspian Sea. E. Peltsam". Mr. E. Peltsam worked in Kazan University until the end of the 19th Century, and no doubts may remain here. In addition, L.S. Berg (1923) reported *T. vulgaris* from near the shores of Aral Sea and Balkhash Lake. All these data do not allow us to refute clearly the possibility of the existence of this species there in the past. The same concerns also exist for *T. cristatus*. Both species could have existed much further to the south than at present. It is known that the climate of the Ural-Turgai region, adjacent to the Aral and Caspian seas, was much wetter, and the territory was much more forested in the past than at present. For example, beavers existed in the Emba River (P.P. Suchkin in Kulagin, 1921). This was confirmed by researches by S.V. Kirikov (1959), who reported the existence of dense riparian bushes on the riverbanks of Emba in the past, which would have provided food for beavers. One of the tributaries of the Emba is even called Kunduzdy, i.e. Beaver River.

Past existence of *Hyla arborea* in the Volga-Kama Region poses a special problem. This tree frog has not been reported in this region during the last 100 years, although naturalists did report it earlier. I.P. Falk (1786) reported this species on the rivers Volga and Ural and even in Siberia, near Tobolsk City. The tree frog was mentioned among other amphibians in one of the volumes of "Economic Description of Perm Province" (1813). P.S. Pallas ([1814]) wrote that "*Rana arborea*" exists on the Volga River and, very rarely, in the Southern Siberia. E. Eichwald (1841) reported records of *H. arborea* on the lower Volga. E.A. Eversmann, however, did not note tree frogs in the description of his travels to the South-Western Urals. K. Zerrener (1853) reported that tree frogs occur fairly often in forests and forest rides in the Permskaya Province. L.P. Sabaneev (1872, 1874) did not observe the tree frog in the Urals, but mentioned some data that "frogs living on trees occur seldom on the south-western slope of the Urals, in linden forests of Nyazepetrovskaya dacha [forest area – S.K.]". V.V. Belov (1887) mentioned the existence of tree frogs in the former Orlovskii County of Vyatskaya Province (now Khalturiskii District of Kirovskaya Province). N.A. Zarudnoi (1896) noted that the tree frog occurs in a fairly small number in Karavaevskaya dacha near the city of Orenburg.

(now it is living district of this city). Two decades later A.M. Nikolsky (1918) considered the Don River as the eastern margin of range of this species. He noted that the tree frog was not certainly found along any part on the Volga River. N.D. Grigoriev, a zoologist from Kazan City, heard from hunters in 1960s that frogs living on trees occur in the area of Nyazepetrovsk Town at the north-west of Chelyabinskaya Province, Ufa River basin. Although the bulk of this data contain many dubious sources, we can not doubt the evidence of such eminent naturalists as I.G. Georgi, L.P. Sabaneev and N.A. Zarudnoi. Therefore, the supposition that the tree frog lived on the Volga and the Southern Urals and became extinct later seems to be reasonable. There were no significant climatic changes in these territories during the last 200 years. Therefore, anthropogenic alteration of habitats, and destruction of forests in particular, might provide the cause for extinction of this species. However, better conditions of humidity and density of river network in the past cannot be excluded, especially if we consider the past distribution of beavers and their activity in changing the environment.

Changes produced by people and the subsequent high anthropogenic pressure have combined with natural landscape changes. These are forest cutting, ploughing of steppes and forestless areas, changes in species and age composition of forests, creation of reservoirs along large and medium-sized rivers, urbanization, as well as industrial, agricultural and transport pollution of environment, etc. About 40 years ago, forest cover averaged ca. 21% of the region's area, from 3% in Orenburg Province to 44% in Udmurtia and 52% in Mari El. About 1/3 of their area consisted of secondary birch and aspen forests. In the majority of provinces and republics of the Volga-Kama region, the extent of ploughing varies from 30 to 60% and more. Intensive use of artificial chemicals in agriculture decreased only in the last decade of the 20th Century. Its consequences are not yet completely apparent. Large reservoirs, such as Kuibyshevskoe, Cheboksarskoe, Nizhnekamskoe, Sarapulskoe and Kamskoe, as well as small reservoirs, such as Zainskoe, Karabashskoe, Pavlovskoe etc., consumed flooded meadows, slowed river currents and have became outlets for industrial and other waste. All these influenced the remaining natural water bodies, as well as amphibian populations.

There are 10 cities and towns in the Volga-Kama Region, and 30 of them are large; populations of 5 of them exceed 1 million. There are also many urban agglomerations. Cities, settlements etc. influence local fauna in many ways. The same can be said of mines, sand quarries, oil wells, transport magistrals, electric lines, etc. We can note the following aspects of regarding the influence of roads, and especially highways, on animals:

1. Roads as a factor of environmental pollution by heavy metals;
2. Roads as a factor of isolation of populations;
3. Roads as a pathway of dispersal or feeding;
4. Roads as an "ecological riverbed";
5. Roads as a significant mortality factor.

The first factor, pollution, influences amphibians at different stages of their development. It leads to deterioration of the reproductive facilities of a population, its decline and ultimately extinction of a whole population or group of populations, if the animals fail to adapt to the presence of the road.

The second factor causes the isolation of a part of a population or the dividing of a population into several parts which may then develop independently. Populations of *R. lessonae* at lakes Lebyazhie and Glubokie in Kazan City serve as an example of this. This population was divided by the highway between Kazan – Zelenodolsk (Ganeev, 1978).

The third and fourth factors have positive influences on amphibian populations. The presence of food and facilitation of dispersal attract frogs and toads onto roads. The latter are used, for example, by *Bufo viridis* for penetration into forests or for crossing forests. Sometimes these migrants may settle in open areas of forest. Green and brown frogs migrate via ditches along roadsides. These ditches, being filled with water, are used for laying eggs, and are especially unuseful in areas with a deficiency of water. The final factor above also results from this attraction for amphibians, but its influence in such cases is opposite. Mortality on roads is known for all species of our amphibians, but the extent of it is poorly understood. Mortality occurs during migrations of adult individuals to and from their reproduction sites, as well as affecting juvenile migrations from ponds and to hibernacula. To the greatest extent, this concerns the most conservative species: toads, whose populations or separate micropopulations may face extinction after the construction of road through their migration routes, especially after the destruction of their breeding ponds. The same effects follow landscape changes in urbanized areas. Breeding pools represent the most vulnerable habitat of amphibians. Probably, for some species, e.g. *T. cristatus*, *B. bombina* etc., water pollution and the change of water chemistry are important. Sewage waste from cattle farms seem to influence *B. bombina* and *R. lessonae* to a lesser extent. The latter species is more influenced by industrial pollution. It is never found near sites of industrial outpour, in contrast to *R. ridibunda* and, probably, *R. kl. esculenta*. I observed this peculiarity in the 1950s in the area of Saransk City, Insar River.

Among terrestrial frogs, *R. temporaria* is the most sensitive to alterations in the landscape. This species was practically extinct from the city of Kazan after street surfaces were made permanent and construction of stone buildings took place, as well as flooding of the Kazanka River which contained numerous springs. Populations of *Bombina bombina* have declined significantly. The animals are most vulnerable during their autumn and spring migrations between hibernacula and breeding ponds, and they are vulnerable to the effects of frosts during these terrestrial stages. This occurs particularly when frosts occur early in the autumn or late in the spring. Intensive use of agrochemicals in agricultural areas and adjacent water bodies makes the fire-bellied toads more vulnerable. Other causes of the sharp decline of this species are unknown.

The Edible Frog (*Rana kl. esculenta*) is poorly known in the Volga-Kama Region. However, its distribution there represents a very interesting area of research, because the region contains the north-eastern range margins of three species of the *Rana esculenta* complex. Studies of green frogs in the territory of the Volzhsko-Kamskii Nature Reserve revealed not only morphological but also ecological aspects of interspecific differentiation (Korchagina and Garanin, 1996).

DISTRIBUTIONS OF AMPHIBIAN SPECIES

Data on amphibian distributions by provinces and republics of the Volga-Kama Region and adjacent territories are provided in the following order: name of each species (the same on the map); province (*oblast*, in Russian) or republic within Russian Federation and district (*raion*) according to the present administrative subdivision (sometimes *uezd* – county and *guberniya* – province of the past administrative subdivision are indicated); locality (record); author and year (date) of record, communication and/or publication, or the quotation of museum collections are indicated. In the cadastres, the names of districts and provinces are given as a direct transcription from Russian and not in the English fashion (e.g., Samarskaya Province, Stavropolskii District, except for Samara Province, Stavropol District, where the province and district are called after the names of their administrative centres, Samara and Stavropol, respectively). I used my personal material (author's name is not indicated in such cases), as well as material from the following museums: Zoological Institute of Russian Academy of Sciences, St. Petersburg (ZISP), Zoological Museum of Moscow State University (ZMMU), Zoological Museum of Kazan State University (KSU), Zoological Museum of Nizhnii Novgorod (Gorky) State University (NNSU), Museum of Izhevsk Agricultural Institute (MIAI) and the State United Museum of the Republic of Tatarstan (SUMRT). In the 1950s I examined also collections (expositions) of the local museums in the cities of Izhevsk, Ufa, Orenburg, Samara, Ulyanovsk and Saransk. Doubtful data, or data requiring further validation, are indicated by a question mark. More general geographic indications (province and larger) were not included in the lists. Where possible, geographic names are indicated according to the current administrative subdivision and designation. The list of references contains not only formally published works, but also diploma works of students. Authors and, where possible, timing are provided for personal communications. If the data from personal communications were published later, reference to that publication is indicated.




Fig. 2. Distribution of *Triturus vulgaris*.




Fig. 3. Distribution of *Triturus cristatus*.




Fig. 4. Distribution of *Bombina bombina*.




Fig. 5. Distribution of *Pelobates fuscus*.




Fig. 6. Distribution of *Bufo bufo*.




Fig. 7. Distribution of *Bufo viridis*.




Fig. 8. Distribution of *Rana ridibunda*.




Fig. 9. Distributions of *Rana lessonae* and *R. kl. esculenta*.




Fig. 10. Distribution of *Rana arvalis*.




Fig. 11. Distribution of *Rana temporaria*.
